RULES & REGULATIONS /

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF /USHJA RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

It's the rider's responsibility to review and be familiar with the contents of the Competition's rules, policies & procedures. In the event of an inquiry, USEF/USHJA rules will prevail. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.

Horse show management reserves the privilege of substituting or changing judges and/or officials if it becomes necessary. The judge's decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and horse show management accepts no responsibility for these decisions.

Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor/owner shall hold this horse show and the officials, employees and agents of the show blameless for any loss or accident of any kind that may occur while on the show premises.

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages. Additionally, management reserves the right to cancel or combine unfilled classes, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors, and to change rings or rotate judges.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of owners, managers, riders or grooms will not be tolerated. Each incident will be dealt with on an individual basis. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except exhibitors and those having official requested duties to perform.

It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed, and horses properly presented per USEF rules. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds. Minors who have a temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, or losses or actions resulting from that operation.

All minors must have a parent/trainer or guardian sign an entry release. In all cases except for warm-up classes, riders must wear shirts with collars and either boots and breeches or paddock boots and jodhpurs in order to show. All riders and trainers of entries in this show must be members in good standing of GHHJA or pay non-member fees. Horses and ponies competing for year-end awards must be registered, and they owners and trainers must be members. Membership dues are \$275 for lifetime membership, \$45 annual for seniors (age 18 & over), \$40 annual for juniors (under age 18), Owner/Parent/Other annual \$35 and horse/pony registration must be submitted before showing. **A non-member rider or non-member trainer may participate after paying the show secretary a "non-member fee" of \$12.00 per show day.** Lead line participants are exempt from non-member fees. *Duplicate horse/pony names are not allowed. The owner must first check the current registration list to avoid name duplication

Protective Headgear and Numbers

It is compulsory for all persons when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

Protective headgear is required for ALL riders while mounted on horses on the horse show grounds. Junior exhibitors must wear a harness hat approved in accordance with USEF rules. The USEF rule also applies to adults where jumping and when jumping is required (Schooling and Warm-Up rings).

Concessions

The facility offers a concession stand, on-site restaurant and restrooms.

Description of Courses

Courses will be in accordance with standard USEF guidelines.

Arena Dimensions and Footings: Main Indoor Arena measures 175' X 275' | Small Indoor Arena measures 216' X 93' | Outdoor Arena measures 100' X 230'

All arenas have European state of the art footing with permanent irrigation systems.

Dogs

All dogs must be kept on a leash or confined in a stall. Loose dogs will be impounded. Impounded dogs would be charged \$100.00, which will be donated to the local humane society. Loud or unruly dogs will be asked to leave.

Drugs & Medications

Current USEF rules relating to drugs & medications will be enforced.

A SHARPS DISPOSAL CONTAINER WILL BE AVAILABLE IN STABLING AREA ON THE SHOW GROUNDS

Entries

All entry blanks must be totally completed in full and signed by all applicable parties. Payment must be made in full prior to the start of competition. Post entries will be accepted with a late fee and added up until the start of the said class taking place. Entry numbers will not be provided without an open check or credit card online. **Scratches must be in writing 24 hours in advance or subject to office and shaving restocking fees**

Schooling

Schooling will be allowed Friday at noon until dusk and Saturday & Sunday morning until 30 mins prior to the start of show – Designated lunging and schooling areas will be posted and available during the show.

Hazardous Weather/ Act of GOD/ Accident Policy

Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, acts of GOD, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, acts of GOD, accidents or emergencies.

Medic – Medic will be on premises just prior to the start and throughout the horse show hours only. **Any riding, schooling, lunging, or an equine interaction that occurs while medic is not present will be done at risk and responsibility of the individual.**

Exhibitors

All riders in any class where jumping is required/ or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear. Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance.

Junior Exhibitors

Individuals that have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. Junior's under 14 years of age cannot show a stallion. JUNIOR'S EXHIBITORS MUST WEAR APPROVED PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR (ASTM/SEI) AT ALL TIMES WHENEVER MOUNTED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. HARNESS MUST BE SECURED AND PROPERLY FITTED. ANY RIDER VIOLATING THIS RULE AT ANY TIME WILL IMMEDIATELY BE PROHIBITED FROM FURTHER RIDING UNTIL SUCH HEADGEAR IS PROPERLY IN PLACE.

Prizes

Jumper Classes 6 ribbons; Champion and Reserve in each division.

Hunter & Equitation classes 6 ribbons; Champion and Reserve in each division.

Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes or to do anything necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries., or GHHJA and/or the show management or employees is not responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any persons, horses or property.

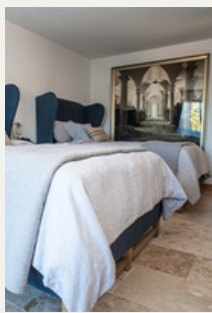
