## Haras Schooling Show Fee Schedule:

### Facility Fees

Weekend Stall (Fri-Sun) – 2 bags shavings \$150/per horse

Weekend Tack Stall (Fri-Sun) - \$125/per stall

Overnight Stall Fee (2 bags shavings included) - \$90/per horse

Overnight Tack Stall - \$75/per stall

Daily Stall Fee (1 bag shaving included) - \$70/per horse

Daily Tack Stall - \$55/per stall

Shavings (per bag) – NO outside shavings allowed - \$15/per bag

Grounds/Haul-In Fee (for horses not stabled on grounds) - \$45/per day

RV hookups (water/electrical) - \$50/per day

EMT Fee - \$15/ per entry

AQHA Fee - \$10 / per horse

**Year End Circuit Award (per year horse/rider combo) - \$35/horse rider combo**

**Entries:** Entries must be submitted on or before the closing date. Entries after the closing date will be considered late and will incur late fees.

All entries must be done online at <https://entry.foxvillage.com>. Complete entries must include a copy of a Coggins taken within 12 months of the show date and **21 Day Health Certificate is required for all horses entering the grounds – NO EXCEPTIONS!!** Entries missing any of these items will be considered incomplete. Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, entries may be limited. Those entries submitted after closing will be accepted at the discretion of the show secretary, based on a space available basis and charged a late fee per show. If the classes are oversubscribed, a Waiting List (in order of receipt) will be maintained. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

**Entry Requirements: A 21 Day Health Certificate is required for all horses entering the grounds – NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

Complete entries must include a copy of a Coggins taken within 12 months,

**Official Ride Times:** Stabling assignments and provisional times will be emailed and available to competitors <https://harashacienda.com/calendar.html#>. Official times will be available at noon the day before the show.

**Refund Policy:** Cancellations before the closing date will be refunded, less than \$40 office fees.

**Hazardous Weather/Act OF God/Accident Policy:** Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents or emergencies.

**Schedule:** Classes may not necessarily be run in the order listed in the class lists. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the show secretary of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes, and modify the schedule, and to modify or cancel awards and/or make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition specifications listed herein. Show Management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry for cause deemed sufficient by Show Management.

**Non-competes** horses are allowed on grounds, if space is available. Owner must fill out an entry form and pay office and stall fees. Must also provide a copy of Coggins.

**All horses must wear show numbers at all times when out of stalls**

**ALL riders must wear helmets when mounted**

**Stabling:** Stalls are 10x10 permanent stalls with full doors. Stall charts will be posted online, and check-in will start at 4:00 PM on Friday prior to show.

**Arenas/Footing/Warm-Up:** All tests are ridden in an arena with state of the art, European footing with permanent irrigation system.

**Concessions:** The facility offers a concession stand and on-site restaurant.

**Children/Pets:** Well-mannered dogs are welcome, must always be on a leash. Loose dogs will be impounded and will incur a \$100 fee which is donated to the local humane society. Children and dogs require adult supervision at all times.

**Ribbons and Awards:** Ribbons awarded 1st through 6th place for all levels. Ribbons and tests will be available after class has been pinned. Management reserves the right to combine classes for awards purposes if the class has two or less competitors.

**High Point Award:** High Point awards for top Junior, Amateur and Open riders separated between Classical and Western Dressage

**Year End Circuit Awards:** 1<sup>st</sup> = 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 6 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 4 points, 4<sup>th</sup> = 2 points, 5<sup>th</sup> = 1 point, 6<sup>th</sup> = .5 point. High Point = 10 points, Reserve High Point = 5 points.

***All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision will be final.***

***Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.***

***The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.***

***Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom, shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.***

***Show management reserves for itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.***

***No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform.***

***It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitable to appear before an audience.***

## ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering the Haras Dressage Schooling Show (the "Competition") and signing this entry blank on behalf of myself, my child, my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the applicable rules governing the competition (i.e., the rules of the USEF/USDF) as well as the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Rules. I will accept as final the decision of the competition officials on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the licensing organization, their officials, directors, employees, agents and assigns for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/ or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, and/or the licensing organization.

Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product, and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or misappropriation. The construction and application of the Rules are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, and all actions to enforce, dispute or assert any claims under this agreement shall be brought in the courts of the competent jurisdiction in Harris County, Texas

### Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification

*This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.*

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse as a rider owner, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including, but not limited to, broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (collectively "Harm").

I AGREE to release the Competition and Confederation for Working Equitation, USEF, USDF or other sponsoring organization (hereinafter "the applicable sponsoring organization") from all claims for damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse, and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the HARM resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of HARM to me, my horse, and/or my child, including HARM resulting from the negligence of the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the competition and the applicable sponsoring organization, and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me, my horse, and/or my child, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me, my horse, and/or my child at the Competition. I understand that my child and I are required to wear protective equipment.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to my child's participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on behalf of my child.

I AGREE that the "Competition" as used herein includes all of the officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, and volunteers of the Competition, the applicable sponsoring organization as well as any affiliated organizations.

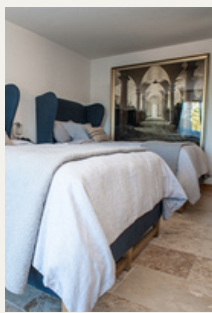

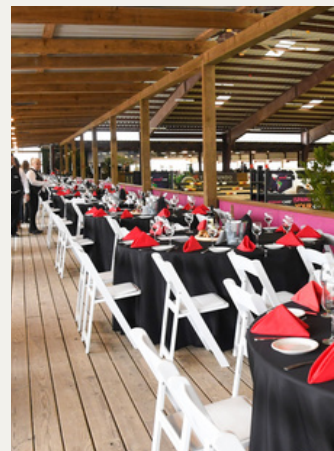

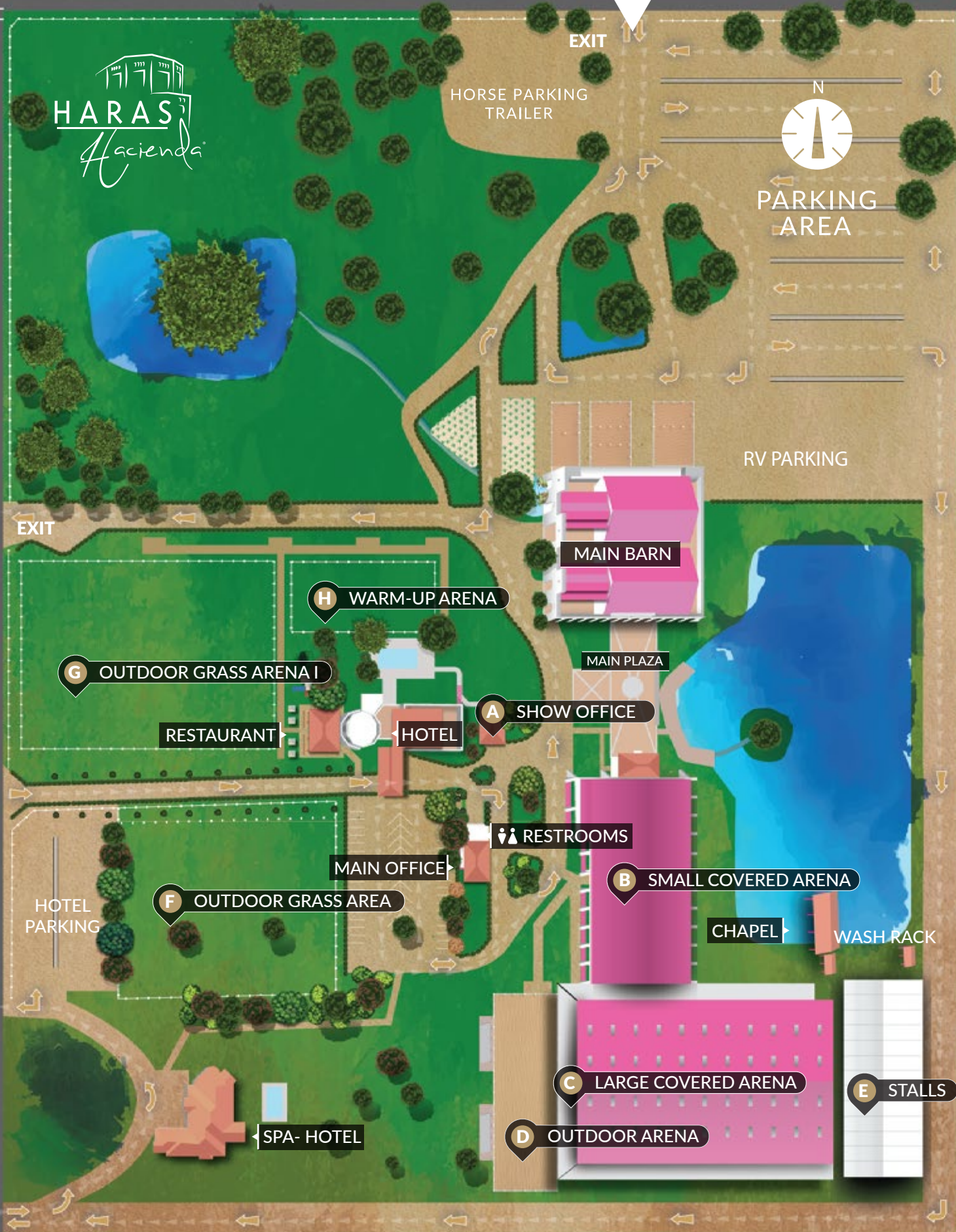
