REGULATIONS & PRIZE LIST

The 2026 USLA/APSL Rising Stars Model & Movements Challenge is a North American Lusitano breed evaluation event conducted under USLA/APSL regulations and judged by APSL-recognized Lusitano judges. The competition emphasizes morphology, movement, functionality, presentation, and the continued advancement of the Purebred Lusitano in North America.

The USLA/APSL Rising Stars Model & Movements Challenge is held as part of the 2026 USLA Lusitano Conference weekend, which also includes educational programs, clinics, and special events dedicated to the Lusitano horse.

The weekend event also includes an HDS-recognized Dressage Schooling Show, which is open to all breeds.

Online Entries

Fox Village

Article 1 — Entries

Entries for the USLA/APSL Rising Stars Model & Movements Challenge will be completed online through Fox Village.

All horses entered in the competition must be APSL registered.

All competitors must hold a current USLA membership prior to competition.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to accept or decline entries.

Article 2 — Admission

All horses entered in the USLA/APSL Rising Stars Model & Movements Challenge must be presented to the Admission Jury prior to competition.

Horses may not compete without presentation to the Admission Jury.

Article 3 — Veterinary Requirements

All horses entered in the competition must comply with the following veterinary requirements:

- Current Negative Coggins within 12 months
- Current vaccination records including EHV I/IV and Equine Influenza
- 21-Day Health Certificate
- Official equine identification documents

Horses must be free from contagious disease.

Competition management reserves the right to refuse admission to any horse deemed unfit or unsafe.

Article 4 — Judging

The competition will be judged by APSL-recognized Lusitano judges.

Judges' decisions are final.

Each presenter will have approximately 2 minutes 30 seconds for in-hand classes and 3 minutes for mounted classes.

Placings will be awarded through fourth place.

Article 5 — Awards & Prize Money

Ribbons will be awarded through fourth place.

APSL Gold Medals will be awarded to horses receiving classifications of Excellent.

APSL Silver Medals will be awarded to horses receiving classifications of Very Good.

- Proof of registration in the APSL Studbook
- Ability to be presented in-hand, standing, and in all three gaits as required by the class
- Mounted horses must be capable of presentation under saddle and in-hand as required by the class
- Presenters must be appropriately attired and horses properly turned out for presentation
- Attire and tack may reflect Portuguese, dressage, western, working equitation, or other well-defined equestrian traditions appropriate to the horse's training and presentation, provided horse and presenter are presented in a consistent and professional manner
- The use of assistants carrying whips or sticks to encourage movement is prohibited

Mounted stallions must demonstrate full morphological development of the genital organs, subject to review by the Admission Jury.

Group classes do not advance to championships but will count toward the Best Breeder award.

Article 8 — Presenters & Riders

In mounted classes, each rider may present only one horse per class.

Presenters and riders are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and sportsmanlike manner at all times.

Presenters competing for the Best Presenter award are encouraged to present horses in attire and tack that reflect a consistent and appropriate equestrian tradition for the horse being presented.

Article 9 — Responsibility

Transportation, feeding, handling, stabling, and care of horses during the competition remain the responsibility of the owners and exhibitors.

The competition, organizers, officials, and facility management are not responsible for loss, damage, injury, illness, or accident to horses, riders, handlers, spectators, or property.

Article 10 — General

Any matters not specifically addressed within these regulations will be resolved by competition management and the judging panel.

Official ride times will be considered final once published by competition management.

All mounted riders on competition grounds must wear properly fitted protective headgear meeting ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use.

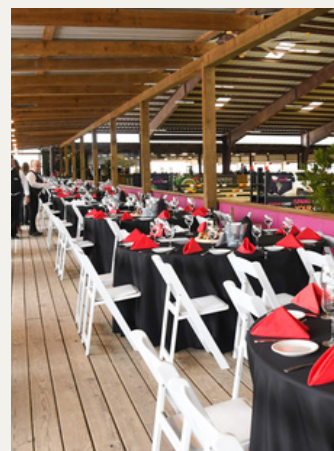

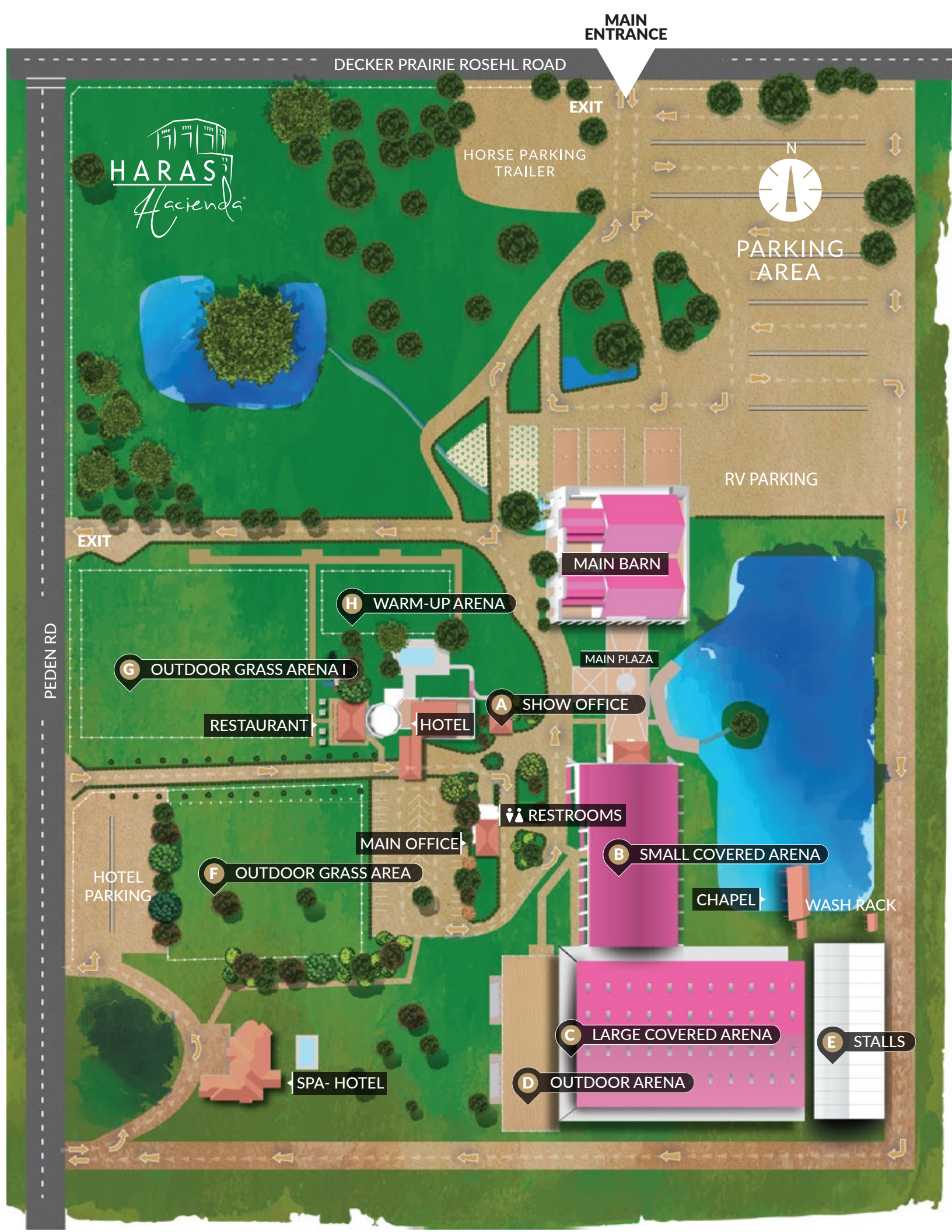
