All Centex riders in the show must be members of the Centex Hunter and Jumper Association. Current dues are \$40 for individuals and \$60 for families. Dues may be paid at the show or sent to the Association secretary. No points will be credited prior to payment of dues and payment of dues is solely the responsibility of the member. The fee for the entire **Haras Series** is \$35.00 per horse/rider combination

Points will validate upon series registration date and will not be retroactive for any points accrued prior to that registration date. **Points will be awarded to valid entries based on division specs outlined in the prize list.** Horse/rider combinations must be eligible to receive points. Be aware cross entries may alter eligibility. Series end ribbons Champion thru 6th place and awards will be presented at year-end Christmas show.

Points will be tallied as horse/rider combination per division, with the exception of walk trot, crossrails, and verticals. Those 3 divisions will be tallied by rider only. Awards will be based on participation.

RULES & REGULATIONS /

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF/USHJA and CTHJA RULE BOSOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

It's the rider's responsibility to review and be familiar with the contents of the Competition's rules, policies & procedures. In the event of an inquiry, CTHJA rules will first prevail otherwise USEF/USHJA rules will prevail.

All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decisions shall be final.

Horse show management reserves the privilege of substituting or changing judges and/or officials if it becomes necessary. The judge's decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and horse show management accepts no responsibility for these decisions.

Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor/owner shall hold this horse show and the officials, employees and agents of the show blameless for any loss or accident of any kind that may occur while on the show premises.

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages. Additionally, management reserves the right to cancel or combine unfilled classes, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors, and to change rings or rotate judges.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of owners, trainers, managers, riders or grooms will not be tolerated. Each incident will be dealt with on an individual basis.

No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except exhibitors and those having official requested duties to perform.

It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed, and horses properly presented per CTHJA and/or USEF rules. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds. Minors who have temporary licenses may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent (s), legal guardian (s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims or losses or actions resulting from that operation.

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless EEC, Central Texas Hunter Jumper Association (CTHJA), and Haras officials against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against EEC, CTHJA, and Haras Management by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by council acceptable to the owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and EEC, CTHJA, and Haras Management is not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft. It is the responsibility of the show management, exhibitors, trainers, and spectators to conduct themselves in a civilized and sportsmanlike manner. It is the responsibility of all trainers and exhibitors to be familiar with the CTHJA Rulebook.

Protective Headgear and Numbers

Approved SEI Protective headgear must be worn by all riders at all times when mounted. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

Concessions

The facility offers a concession stand, and on-site restaurant and restrooms.

Description of Arenas

Main Indoor Arena measures 175' x 275'

Small Indoor Arena measures 216' x 93'

Outdoor Arena measures 100' x 230'

All arenas have European state of the art footing with permanent irrigation systems.

Dogs

All dogs must be kept on a leash or confined in a stall. Loose dogs will be impounded.

Impounded dogs would be charged \$100.00, which will be donated to the local humane society. Loud or unruly dogs will be asked to leave.

Drugs & Medications

Current USEF rules relating to drugs & medications will be enforced.

A SHARPS DISPOSAL CONTAINER WILL BE AVAILABLE IN STABLING AREA ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

Entries

All entry blanks must be totally completed in full and signed by all applicable parties. Payment / Form of payment must be made available in full prior to the start of competition. Post entries will be accepted with a late fee and added up until the start of the said class taking place. **Entry numbers will not be provided without an open check or credit card on file.**

Schooling

Schooling will be allowed Friday at noon until dusk and Saturday & Sunday mornings until 30 mins prior to the start of show. Designated lunging and schooling areas are available during the show. **MEDIC ONLY AVAILABLE DURING ACTIVE SHOW HOURS — SCHOOLING IS PROVIDED AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

Hazardous Weather/ Act of GOD/ Accident Policy

Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, acts of GOD, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, acts of GOD, accidents or emergencies.

Medic

Medic will be on premises throughout the actual hours of the horse show. **Any activity that and individual engages while on the horse show premises to include: riding, schooling, lunging, or any equine interaction; that occurs while medic is not present will be done at risk and responsibility of the individual.**

Exhibitors

All riders in any class where jumping is required/ or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear Approved SEI protective headgear. Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance.

Junior Exhibitors

Individuals that have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. Junior's under 14 years of age cannot show a stallion. JUNIOR'S EXHIBITORS MUST WEAR APPROVED PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR (ASTM/SEI) AT ALL TIMES WHENEVER MOUNTED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. HARNESS MUST BE SECURED AND PROPERLY FITTED. ANY RIDER VIOLATING THIS RULE AT ANY TIME WILL IMMEDIATELY BE PROHIBITED FROM FURTHER RIDING UNTIL SUCH HEADGEAR IS PROPERLY IN PLACE.

Prizes

Ribbons 1st to 6th place for Hunter/Jumper classes. Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded for each division. All association points earned will count toward year-end series awards.

CENTEX 2'6" Medal. The Centex 2'6" Medal class is open to junior and amateur exhibitors. Riders may not cross enter classes with a fence height of 3' or higher at the same show. Any exhibitor qualifying for the 2'6" Medal Final shall be permitted to participate in the Medal Final, and to show in classes with a fence height over 2'6". This shall apply only at the November Horse Show, when the Finals are held, and other division restrictions shall apply. All 2'6" Medal class winners, as well as the top five non-winners (as determined by points), will be invited to participate in the Final. Riders must qualify for the final PRIOR to the show designated for the final. A work-off is required in the finals but is optional prior to the finals. U.S. Equestrian Tests 1-9 may be used in any work-off. . Riders qualifying for both Medal Finals must declare Final in which they will participate prior to the start of the Final Show.

****Green Hunter.** Centex allows horses and ponies two "green" years. It is based on the U.S. Equestrian year and showing in December is counted with the next year. However, if a horse shows over fences 3'6" in height or higher at ANY show, it is no longer considered "green". Participation in flat classes will not affect the "green" status of a horse. I agree to be bound by the Rules and to the applicable codes of conduct. I will accept as final the decision of the Competition officials on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, its officials, directors, employees, independent contractors, premises owners, agents and assigns for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition or future competitions.

Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably wave and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or misappropriation. The construction and application of the Rules are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, and all actions to enforce, dispute, or assert any claims under this agreement shall be brought in the courts of the competent jurisdiction in Harris County, Texas.

RELEASE ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE that in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, owner or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including, but not limited to, broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (collectively "Harm")

I AGREE to release the governing rulebook and association presiding over the horse show to include USEF, USDF, HDS, USHJA, FEI, GHHJA, CTHJA Horseshowsonline.com, the Competition, their officials, directors, employees, independent contractors, agents and assigns from all claims for damages or otherwise for any harm caused by me, my child or my horse at the Competition. I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to my child's participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on behalf of my child.

I AGREE that "Competition" as used herein includes all of the officials, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors, premises owners, agents, personnel, and volunteers of the Competition, as well as any affiliated organizations.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this Competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to Competition management. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this Competition.
